3. Identify research and data that show the need for and benefits of effective comprehensive school health education programs and curricula;
4. Share effective advocacy skills and resources supporting comprehensive school health education;
5. Provide opportunity for inter-district sharing and networking; and
6. Provide an opportunity for district “team time” for curriculum development.

Dr. Telljohann’s experience in health education spans over 25 years, including health instruction from the junior high to the university level.

She has conducted research and published over 60 articles on health education in professional journals, is the co-author of *Health Education: Elementary and Middle-Level School Applications, 6th Edition* (McGraw-Hill, 2007) and is co-author of the *HealthSmart K-12 Curriculum* and *Teach and Reach Health Series* published by ETR Associates. She was one of the lead authors on the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention’s *Health Education Curriculum Analysis Tool* (HECAT), the Contributing Editor for the Teaching Ideas Column in the *American Journal of Health Education* and served on the National Health Education Standards Revision Committee.
