SLADE MIDDLE SCHOOL

**From New York State, Danbury,
Waterbury via I-84 East:**

Take exit #35 to Route 72 East (left-hand exit). Take the first exit off Route 72, which is Corbin Avenue. Turn right at the light at the end of the exit. At the second traffic light, turn right onto Steele Street. Travel approximately 1/4 mile up Steele Street. Slade is located on the right side behind Lincoln Elementary School.

**From Massachusetts or Hartford via I-91
to I-84 West:**

Take exit #35 to Route 72 East (left-hand exit). Take the first exit off Route 72, which is Corbin Avenue. Turn right at the light at the end of the exit. At the second traffic light, turn right onto Steele Street. Travel approximately 1/4 mile up Steele Street. Slade is located on the right side behind Lincoln Elementary School.

**From Rhode Island, New London,
Middletown via Route 9 North and New
Haven, Meriden via Route 9 to (Exit #22)
Route 9 North:**

Take Route 9 North through the center of New Britain. Bear left onto Route 72 (exit #28). Travel approximately 2 miles west on Route 72 and take Corbin Avenue exit. Turn left at the light at the end of the exit. At the third traffic light, turn right on Steele Street. Travel approximately 1/4 mile up Steele Street. Slade is located on the right side behind Lincoln Elementary School.
