## PRAXIS I WAIVER CRITERIA

Praxis I waiver criteria have been updated to include criteria for the new GRE scoring format. Options for waiver of the Praxis I Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST) requirement are as follows:

If you have taken the SAT/ACT/GRE on more than one occasion, your highest verbal score and your highest mathematics scores will be combined.

**Applying for the Praxis I Waiver:**

1. Create an account on the Connecticut Educator Certification System (CECS).  
If you have not yet created an online account, go to [www.ct.gov/sde/cert](http://www.ct.gov/sde/cert) and click on the blue CECS box near the top of the page.
2. Apply for the waiver online.
3. Submit official score report by US mail to our office at the address below.

The paper application is still available for printing at [www.ct.gov/sde/certapps](http://www.ct.gov/sde/certapps) for those who cannot access the online system only.

**Reporting GRE Scores:**

The Educational Testing Service (ETS) retains individual GRE test records for a period of five years. If you have taken the GRE within the past five years, please contact ETS online at [www.gre.org](http://www.gre.org) or call 888-473-7267 to order an official score report. Applicants themselves must then forward the original score report in the sealed envelope to our office at:
