

## Foreign Language Cross-Endorsements

**French, 7-12 (018) – German, 7-12 (019)**  
**Italian, 7-12 (020) – Latin, 7-12 (021)**  
**Russian, 7-12 (022) – Spanish, 7-12 (023)**  
**Other World Language, 7-12 (024)**  
**World Language Instructor – Elementary (101)**

*Please note that these are only general guidelines. Approval and/or acceptance of specific coursework will be determined once an application, fee, and official transcripts have been submitted for review.*

### **Foreign Language, 7-12 (#018, #019, #020, #021, #022, #023, #024)**

- 24 semester hours of credit in the foreign language\*  
OR 18 credits if coursework begins at intermediate level;  
OR 12 credits if coursework begins at advanced level
- three semester hours of credit in methods and materials for teaching foreign language
- three semester hours of credit in language acquisition
- passing scores on the ACTFL OPI and WPT in the foreign language\*\*

\* Scores of “Advanced High” or higher on both the ACTFL OPI and WPT tests may be accepted to meet credit requirements in the foreign language. Methods & materials course and language acquisition course are still required.

\*\* The passing score for French, German, Italian and Spanish is “Advanced Low.”  
The passing score for Portuguese, Russian, Mandarin Chinese and other world languages is “Intermediate High.”

### **World Language Instructor – Elementary (#101)**

- Must hold or meet all requirements for a secondary foreign language certificate
- Three semester hours of credit in language acquisition **in young children**
- Three semester hours of credit in methods and materials for teaching foreign language **at the elementary level.**
