The Paraprofessional Educator Certificate: Refines teaching skill sets as they relate to working with students in an educational setting and enhancing opportunities for career advancement.

- **Exceptional Learners/Paraprofessional-January to March 2014 - (EDU 102)**
This course provides insight into the characteristics of each of the law's disability categories and looks at the academic and behavioral strategies designed to assist students with disabilities.
- **Autistic Learner & Assistive Technology- March to May 2014 (EDU 103)**
An examination of specific academic and behavioral strategies employed to assist autistic students in the classroom. It additionally explores the various assistive technology used to promote student independence and learning.

The Speech and Language Pathology Assistant Certificate: Coursework is designed to assist participants in mastering the skills required to address the language, communication, social/emotional and creative needs of school children.

- **Introduction to Language and Communication Development -January to April 2014- (COM 102)**
This course provides students with an overview of the normal process of language and communication development and its relationship to social, physical, psychological and cognitive development, including the components of phonology, syntax, semantics, and pragmatics.
- **Standards and Practices for SLPAs-March to May 2014 (COM 103)**
This course addresses the professional issues related to the role of the Speech Language Pathology Assistant in providing services in the educational setting. Topics covered will include the legal and policy framework for school services, ethical practice, supervision, collaboration, scheduling, service delivery models, data collection, advocating, professional development, resources and professional trends.
