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<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	<p>Grade two students are identified according to their strengths in math and language arts. They work with the TAG resource teacher in learning centers in their classrooms. Students in grades three through five are identified according to their strengths in one or more of the following areas: math, language arts and interdisciplinary science. The math and language arts strands, taught by the TAG teachers, replace the regular classroom program. The interdisciplinary science strand is a pull-out program for ninety minutes per week also taught by the TAG teacher. In grades 6-8 identified students participate in an interdisciplinary Seminar Program taught by the TAG teacher. Seminar students analyze and discuss ideas, engage in research and apply what they have learned to social problems. There is also an accelerated math program. Each of our elementary programs is staffed by full-time TAG teachers and there is a part-time TAG teacher in each of the middle schools. Two full time TAG resource teachers deliver the grade two TAG program in the eleven elementary schools.</p>
