

HIDDEN NUMBERS

PREPARATION: For each pair, make two copies on card stock of the Hundred Number Board Sections (pages A.52-55). On one copy, cut the squares apart to make the tiles. On the other copy, cut the borders off so children can tape the four sections to make their board.

How To Play Hidden Numbers

1. Partners put Number Tiles 1 to 100 in the correct places on the Hundred Number Board.
2. One player hides his eyes, as the other turns over one of the tiles to hide a number.
3. The first player looks and tries to name the hidden number.
4. The players turn the tile over to check the number.
5. Players take turns hiding eyes and hiding numbers.

Possible adaptations:

- Use only one part of the Number Board and follow rules above.
- Use entire Number Board but have student turning numbers over, turn over 3 to 4 numbers for their partner.
