This project is designed for you to look at the many options of your two selected cars. You must first find two cars you might consider to buy, then create a one page flyer for each car advertising the listed information you find below.

- You may use any internet site that you wish with appropriate information to complete each area of criteria for this project.

Find "2" different cars on the internet: cars can be new or used

For each car:

1. Car Make	Car # 1:	Car #2:	Example: BMW
2. Car Model			525i
3. Car Year			2007
4. Car Price			\$25,500
5. Car Mileage			67,000
6. Car Color			black
7. Is the car new or used?			Used
8. How many doors? Example 2dr, 4dr			4 dr
9. MPG= Miles per gallon, City and Highway.			City: 20 Highway: 25
10. Why would you want to purchase this car? Come up with a catchy quote to add to your flyer/advertisement?			This isn't your parent's car!

50 points for each flyer = 5 points for each of the 10 given assigned points for each part of the flyer/advertisement.

- A picture of each car is required to be on the flyer. Make sure the picture is the exact picture of the car your advertising.
