The following information is provided to update and clarify the Area Eligible Elementary Schools List transmitted with Operational Memorandum # 10-H-05:

1. The following additional area eligible town and/or school is new to the list since last year:

Naugatuck	Salem School
Stamford	Hart School
Vernon	Maple Street School
2. Although the Micro Society Magnet School is a new area eligible school, it is not on the list for CACFP eligibility because it is not an elementary school and may not be used as an area school for Tier I eligibility.
3. The Central Avenue School in Naugatuck is no longer an area eligible school.
4. New street assignment lists/maps are enclosed for Bristol, Danbury and Vernon.
5. Street assignment documents in effect for fiscal year 2003-2004 are still valid in 2004-2005 for the following communities: Ansonia, Bridgeport, Derby, Groton, Hamden, Hartford, Meriden, Middletown, Naugatuck, New Britain, New Haven, New London, Stratford, Torrington, and West Haven and Windham.
