School Area Eligibility Data for “At-Risk” After-School Snack Program**

Attached for your information is the current list of area eligible schools for the “At Risk” After-School Snack Program. This list includes schools where 50% or more of the enrolled children are eligible for free or reduced price meals in the National School Lunch Program in the month of October 2007. The new school data is effective **February 1, 2008** and would impact:

- programs initiating the after school “at-risk” snack program; and
- the re-determination of programs whose current eligibility was based on October 2004 school data distributed in 2005.
