School Area Eligibility Data for “At-Risk” After School Snack Program

Attached for your information is the current list of area eligible schools for the “At Risk” After School Snack Program. This list includes schools where 50% or more of the enrolled children are eligible for free or reduced price meals in the National School Lunch Program in the month of October 2008. The new school data is effective **February 1, 2009**, and would impact:

- programs initiating the after school “at-risk” snack program; and
- the re-determination of programs whose current eligibility was based on October 2005 school data distributed in 2006.

The new list is based on school data from the month of October 2008 and reflects additions and deletions of schools since last year.
