Day Care Home Provider Food Stamp Program Participation

*The Child and Adult Care Food Program: Improving Management and Program Integrity Interim Rule* published on September 1, 2004, required each sponsoring organization of family day care homes to submit an annual list of family day care home providers receiving Tier I benefits on the basis of their participation in the Food Stamp Program.

This memorandum is written to request the submission of that information to this office. The list must include the full name and address of each current provider eligible for Tier I benefits based on Food Stamp participation and must be submitted to this office no later than June 17, 2009. The list should include only those currently participating in CACFP. As required by the interim rule, our agency will submit a statewide list to the Connecticut State Department of Social Services within 30 days of receipt of the information.
