**School Area Eligibility Data for “At-Risk” After School Snack/Supper Program**

Attached for your information is the current list of area eligible schools for the “At Risk” After School Snack/Supper Program. This list includes schools where 50% or more of the enrolled children are eligible for free or reduced price meals in the National School Lunch Program in the month of October 2009. The new school data is effective **February 1, 2010**, and would impact:

- programs initiating an “at-risk” after school snack/supper program; and
- the re-determination of programs whose current eligibility was based on October 2006 school data distributed in 2007.

The new list is based on school data from the month of October 2009 and reflects additions and deletions of schools since last year.
