Dear Parents,

On an annual basis, the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE), Bureau of Special Education (BSE) conducts general supervision student file reviews for students with disabilities as well as focused monitoring technical assistance and support activities. The activities are designed to assist districts with improving their performance on a set of key performance indicators for students with disabilities and to ensure compliance with the implementation of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (IDEA).

Based on a six-year cycle, approximately thirty school districts per school year are randomly selected for initial inclusion in general supervision student file review for students with disabilities designed to monitor districts for compliance with IDEA. Subsequently, through a comprehensive selection process, a smaller cohort of those thirty districts is identified to participate in a more focused monitoring process of technical assistance and support. This process assists in addressing any data of concern noted during the selection process. This year, our district has been selected to receive that additional technical assistance and support.

The following data of concern was identified for our district through the Focused Monitoring process based on data reported to the State for student with disabilities:

A team of BSE, State Education Resource Center (SERC) and CT Parent Advocacy Center (CPAC) consultants has been assembled to assist our district. In addition to the student file reviews already conducted, this team will offer our district four sessions of embedded activities including further root cause analysis of our data for students with disabilities, identification of a focus for improvement related to the district data of concern, electronic parent and staff surveys, an exploration of the district infrastructure to support improvement and build capacity, facilitation of a reflective district self-study, and facilitation of the development of a Focused Monitoring Theory of Action Plan.

It is anticipated that the consultant team will begin Focused Monitoring activities with our district in January 2014 and conclude by the close of the school year, after which we will continue to actively pursue the goals and objectives developed in our Focused Monitoring Theory of Action Plan.
