Workshop overview and objectives:

Develop a comprehensive school health education curriculum that increases knowledge, builds essential skills and addresses the health needs of children and youth in grades prek-12. Bring a small team of professionals (3-4) to develop or update existing health education curriculum for your school district.

This two-day curriculum development institute will:

1. Provide an overview of national and state health education standards, state mandates and recommendations for policy, program and curriculum in comprehensive school health education;
2. Provide national and state resources and guidance for curriculum development and evaluation;
3. Identify research and data that show the need for and benefits of effective comprehensive school health education programs and curricula;
4. Provide opportunity for inter-district sharing and networking; and
5. Provide an opportunity for district/school "team time" for curriculum development.

Curriculum coordinators, administrators, Health Educators, Family Consumer Science Teachers, Classroom Teachers, Nurses, and anyone who has responsibility for developing and teaching Health Education curriculum in grades PreK-12. **Participants are encouraged to attend in small writing teams of 3-4 people.**
