
2010 Conference Math + SRBI = Student Learning

When registering online, applicants must register individually, and will be placed into teams according to school/district. Applicants will be selected on a first-come, first-served basis.

There is a fee of **\$75.00** per applicant for the conference. Lunch will be provided. Please make check payable to **Rensselaer at Hartford**. Purchase orders will be accepted, but payment **must** be received prior to the conference.

The closing date for submitting applications is **Tuesday, September 14, 2010**.

SERC will award .7 CEUs. To qualify for CEUs, participants must be preregistered, receive written confirmation from SERC, complete a conference evaluation form, and provide evidence of post-conference application/reflection.
